Look What We're Learning

Reading: This week we will be learning how to summarize a nonfiction text. Students will need to find the main idea of the text and the main idea of each paragraph/subsection to write their summary.

Math: In math, we continue to practice computation daily (addition, subtraction, 2x2 multiplication) along with area and perimeter problems. Students will be learning about the various attributes of shapes this week. For example, a square has two pairs of parallel lines and four right angles.

Grammar & Writing: In writing, students will be choosing their topics for writing a persuasive text. We will also be learning about the difference between similes and metaphors.

Vocabulary: We will not have vocabulary this week! Instead, we will be reviewing how to use context clues to figure out unfamiliar words.
