Look What We're Learning

Reading: This week we will be wrapping up summarizing fiction and nonfiction texts. The students will be asked to review finding main idea within a nonfiction text in order to help them write a summary. We will also be reviewing and learning test taking strategies.

Math: In math, we continue to practice computation daily (addition, subtraction, 2x2 multiplication). This week we will be introducing measuring angles using a protractor! Students will learn how to measure angles given as well as draw an angle given the measurement.

Grammar & Writing: In writing, students will begin working on their persuasive writing piece. They will research and identify reasons for and against their topic. In grammar, students will continue learning about figurative language, specifically idioms and hyperboles.

Vocabulary: Our vocabulary quiz this Friday will cover 8 Greek/Latin roots. Students will be quizzed over whether they can apply their knowledge of these Greek/Latin root words (listed on the back) to identify the meaning of given words.
