Look What We're Learning

Reading: This week we will introduce a new text structure. Students will be reading nonfiction texts that compare and contrast. They will find similarities and differences to create Venn diagrams. Additionally, students will complete constructed responses by supporting their opinions with details from the text.

Math: In math, we will continue to practice computation (addition, subtraction, 2x2 multiplication, 4x1 multiplication). We will also continue to practice problem solving when given a word problem. This week, we will finish up our unit on measuring angles and using protractors.

Grammar & Writing: In writing, students will continue to work on their persuasive writing by building a strong argument for their opinion. Once their writing is complete they will begin revisions. In grammar, students will learn about coordinating and subordinating conjunctions.

Vocabulary: Our vocabulary quiz this Friday will cover suffixes. There will be 10 vocabulary words using suffixes students should study this week. The list is on the back.
