## Look What We're Learning

**Reading:** We continue to work on sequencing. This week we will look at "Real World" texts such as recipes, directions to games, and how to assemble items. Students will identify the steps necessary by using transition words and time. We will be using a graphic organizer to help us keep track of the steps.

**Math:** The kids are discussing many strategies they can use to help them solve problems such as  $25 \times 7$  or  $132 \times 4$ . The kids have figured out how they can use repeated addition, use place value, and some are starting to use the "traditional" way to multiply.

**Grammar & Writing:** We have extended verb tenses for another week and the students are picking their Native American tribe and beginning their research in class. It will take us a while to complete the writing project, but at the end, students will be writing a three paragraph essay.

**Vocabulary:** Our Greek and Latin roots for the week are hydr- (water), -ance, -ence (state, quantity) and -ness (state, condition) The words and definitions are on the back of the newsletter.
