Look What We're Learning

Reading: We begin our three week study of visualizing and inferencing. Visualizing is when a reader uses the author's words to create a "movie" in their mind. A reader uses all of their senses to visualize. When a reader infers, they "read between the lines". A reader uses the author's words and their own background knowledge about a subject to help them understand what the author is saying.

Math: Multiplication is an ongoing skill we practice daily in the classroom. Students will also be working on multiples (skip counting), finding the factors of a number, and understanding the difference between prime and composite numbers.

Grammar & Writing: We continue to work on our Native American projects. The students have begun taking their research and writing what they have learned into paragraphs.

Vocabulary:Our vocabulary words this week will include words with the prefixes ex-, non-, and in-. A complete list of the vocabulary words are on the back of this newsletter. The test will be on Friday.
