Look What We're Learning

Reading: In our second reading unit, we will look at how an author uses sequencing in a text. Students will learn how to identify key words, use dates, and other clues to help them understand events in both fiction and nonfiction texts.

Math: Students will be using their knowledge of multiplication facts to begin learning how to solve problems such as 42×3 and 182×4 and 3149×2 . Students need to have a good understanding of basic multiplication facts. Please practice multiplication facts nightly.

Grammar & Writing: In grammar, students will be learning about verb tenses and in writing we will begin our research project about Native Americans. Students will choose a Native American tribe from Indiana, create a graphic organizer, research, and write a report in class.

Vocabulary: Our Greek and Latin roots for the week are port- (carry) com- con- co- (with). The words and definitions are on the back of the newsletter.
