Look What We're Learning

Reading: For the next three weeks, we will be learning about main idea and supporting details. This week, we will focus on what is the main idea and how to find details that will support the main idea.

Math: We will still be reviewing place value and addition with regrouping up to the millions place. This week, we will begin reviewing subtraction with regrouping. By the end of the week, students will be practicing subtracting numbers up to the million place value.

Grammar & Writing: In writing, we will learn how to write a constructed response. We will focus on answering questions in complete sentence and using evidence from the text to support our answer. During grammar, we will learn how to write possessives. Students will learn when to add 's and when to add s' depending if the noun is singular or plural.

Vocabulary: Our next vocabulary unit will cover the Greek and Latin roots and prefixes cred (believe), de- and dis- (opposite, against). The quiz over these words will be on Friday and the list of vocabulary words, definitions, and examples are on the back of this newsletter.
